WHAT IS LEWISVILLE-CLEMMONS YOUNG PROFESSIONALS (LCYP)?

Lewisville-Clemmons Young Professionals (LCYP), a program of the Lewisville-Clemmons Chamber of Commerce, was formed in 2018 for 21 to 40 year olds to create opportunities for young professionals to build relationships, increase value to their employer, develop leadership skills and advance their careers in the business community while promoting economic development within our community.

WHAT IS THE GOAL OF THE YOUNG PROFESSIONALS PROGRAM?

The goal is to involve young professionals and offer them the opportunity to learn and experience the dynamics of advancing causes and the free enterprise system with their community.

Added goals are to engage young professionals, to build their skill set, to encourage collaboration between their age group, and to further leadership positions for the common good.

WHO CAN JOIN LEWISVILLE-CLEMMONS YOUNG PROFESSIONALS?

Young Professionals (21-40) who wish to advance the goals and objectives of the Young Professionals program, the objectives of the Chamber and the overall prosperity of our community.

Chamber Business Members are encouraged to join LCYP and/or qualified professionals from their staff. More than one representative from each business can join the overall membership of LCYP.

There is no annual fee for joining LCYP. This is a benefit offered to the members of the Lewisville-Clemmons Chamber of Commerce.

Young Professionals Membership is open all year to any current member (age 21 to 40) of the Lewisville-Clemmons Chamber of Commerce. Guests/non-members may attend two (2) meetings before joining the group. After two (2) sessions, membership is required.

WHAT IS THE STRUCTURE OF THE LEWISVILLE-CLEMMONS YOUNG PROFESSIONALS PROGRAM?

Lewisville-Clemmons Young Professionals will follow the rules of the Lewisville-Clemmons Chamber of Commerce current Bylaws. The LCYP will have a council in place to act as ambassadors of the program. The council members will be versed in Chamber policy and facilitate/lead the meetings of the LCYP group.

Meeting location the LCYP will meet at an agreeable location that is a member in good standing of the Lewisville-Clemmons Chamber of Commerce.

LCYP Council Chairs will plan the meeting agenda, carry out the program and work with the Chamber staff and other leadership roles.

Chamber Liaison the VP of Meetings and Events will oversee the program to assure the program has a grounded foundation that aligns with Chamber objectives.

Chamber Staff Liaison the Communications Coordinator coordinates the LCYP calendar and communications to Chamber members.

Referrals should be to Chamber's Membership we are hopeful that LCYP members not use a Chamber sponsored program to refer business outside the Chamber's membership IF a Chamber member offers that service.
